

INDIA VISA ON ARRIVAL

- Tourist visas are issued at the port of entry for the nationals of the following eleven countries for up to 30 days with single entry at Delhi/Mumbai/ Chennai/ Kolkata airports:
 - Cambodia, Finland, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Luxemburg, Myanmar, New Zealand, Philippines, Singapore and Vietnam
- The Tourist Visa on-arrival will be issued only if the applicant:
 - holds a passport with a minimum validity of six months (and re-entry permit, if required under the law of his/her country)
 - Visits India only for recreation, sightseeing, casual visit to meet friends/relatives, short duration medical treatment or casual business, etc.
 - does not have residence or occupation in India
 - has return air ticket and sufficient funds to meet his expenditure during the trip
 - or either of parents or grandparents (paternal/maternal) was not born in, or was resident in Pakistan
 - is not a persona-non-grata to the Government of India
 - is not considered an undesirable person and is not the subject of a black list or any warning circular or other restrictive list
- A fee of US\$60 is charged for each person, including children. Tourist visa on-arrival will be issued to a tourist for a maximum of two times in a calendar year, with a gap of minimum two months between the visit and it is non-convertible and non-extendable.
